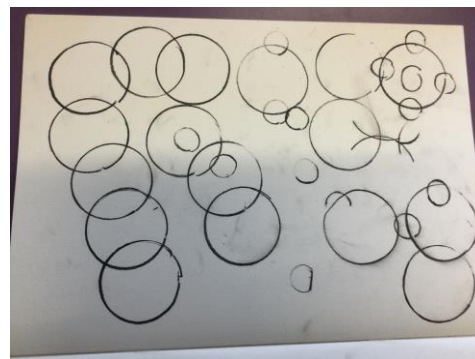
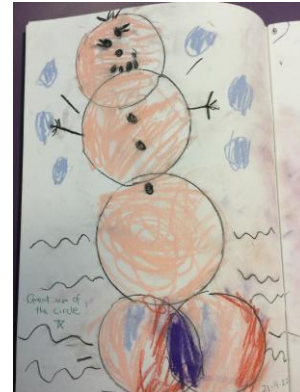
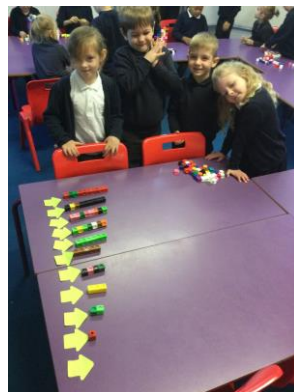
Week beginning 19th September 2022

News from Infants (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)

Reception enjoyed their first full week of school and we are very impressed with our Year 1 children who have been brilliant role models. We have explored 2D shapes and counting backwards this week, as well as practising letter formation. It's so lovely to see how everyone is so enthusiastic about their learning - well done!

Year 2 enjoyed using mixed medium to create circular patterns and pictures this week. We have also shared the story of Billy The Beast.



News from the Juniors

In art, we have been focusing on our theme of bottles with the children looking at how to use shading techniques to create a 3D effect.

Year 3 and 4 joined Mr Dilly Meets Rob Biddulph and Louie Stowell, two authors who have books launching this month. We loved hearing about the different books and finding out how the authors generate ideas and link these to the illustrations which bring the story to life. In maths, we have been improving our place value knowledge.

Year 5 and 6 have been learning and practising strategies to solve problems by multiplying and dividing numbers (including decimals) to 10, 100, 1000. In English, the children are fully engaged in our class text, intrigued by the possibility of a curse threatening the adventure to Egypt's Valley of the Kings. We have been doing intensive research to create information fact files about Tutankhamun.
