# Week beginning 9th October 2023

This week's learning highlights:

News from the Infants (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2)

This week we really enjoyed Lynnsport and are well on our way to achieving our goal of everyone being able to perform a forward roll. We are so close. Not bad for such young children! As well as perfecting our rolling we have also been using our strength to balance, and control our bodies to make shapes in the air whilst on the trampoline. We are getting a lot out of these sessions and we can see great progress.

The Ladybirds have been learning about repeating patterns this week and to start with found this really hard until the year 1's gave them their expert advice! Now they can create a simple repeating pattern using 2 and sometimes 3 colours or items. At home, why don't you look for repeating patterns. They are everywhere. Why not take a photo and send it to us. You could even make your own repeating pattern.



Bees have been exploring the united kingdom this week and can identify its 4 countries and capital cities, locating them on a map. Year 1 made a fantastic playdough model of the U.K. and year 2 have been using mapping skills to locate some important features.

This week the Bees have also been learning about verbs and know they are words to indicate "doing" or "being". We have practiced writing simple sentences using verbs and year 2 can now change the verb to indicate either present or past tense.

News from the Juniors (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)

Life in the Maths Kingdom (cabin) continues to be busy. This week the Y3s have been doing 'seasonal' maths using conkers. We've been sharing, adding and multiplying. To help with learning our times tables the Y4s played a game with playing cards and Nojus was brilliant in explaining the formal written method for adding two 4-digit numbers.







This week we have been busy looking at how the Maya are similar to the Anglo Saxons in how they were ruled and what they did. The children were interested to find out how these two different society's from such vastly different areas could be so similar. We had fun counting in French this week as well. In RE we have been looking at Genesis 1 and how it describes the creation of the world by god. We have then been looking at the scientific theory's, of how the world and the universe began and comparing these to find the similarities between the two. We discussed that not all Christian's have the same views of this and that Genesis can be viewed in different ways. The children did really well and have shown great understanding and empathy in their lessons this week. During collective worship we have also been looking at Black History Month and the children have enjoyed how people in history have had courage to stand up for themselves and others.
