News from the Infants (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2) Ladybirds have been working hard on pencil grip and can now hold with a 'tripod' grip (3 fingers) Thanks to parents for helping practice at home - it has made a big difference. They are a very well behaved group and have settled so well into school routines- it feels like they have been here

forever! They are getting VERY tired but are still working hard.

The Bees have been working on number bonds to 10 and trying to learn them off by heart. The Y2s have been using number bonds to 10 to help with bonds to 100 (10+90, 30+70).

Y1s have focused on using a number line in Maths. They can order numbers to 20 and beyond And have been using the maths vocabulary greater than and less than.

In English, the Bees have been learning how to write questions. Can you practice asking questions at home using 'How', 'Why', What', 'When', 'Where' and 'Who'?



News from the Juniors (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)

We have had a lovely week in the Juniors this week, we have spent some time researching the Maya and creating fact files about them, learning things from the fact that they lived in places such as Guatemala, Belize, Honduras, Yucatán Peninsula and El Salvador. The Maya had many cities that they lived in. In total, it is believed there were 60 of them. They also learn that the sacrifice of human life was the ultimate offering of blood to the gods, and the most important Maya rituals culminated in human sacrifice.
