They also took part in a timed circuits PE session, this got all our heart rates up and our muscles working hard! News from the Juniors (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)

The juniors have had a great week with lots of fun activities. On Monday we had our federation day and hosted Harpley, it was lovely to see all the children catching up with friends they had previously made at a federation day or with those they see outside of school. They had a busy day with lots of tasks including looking at the Maya's writing system, which they found was similar to the Ancient Egyptians hieroglyphics, they then looked at different glyphs and made some from salt dough, these look amazing! We had a go at making and playing some different Maya board games.
