News from the Juniors (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)

The juniors have had a great week with lots of fun activities. On Monday we had our federation day at Massingham, it was lovely to see all the children catching up with friends they had previously made at a federation day or with those they see outside of school.
