News from the Infants (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2)

This week we have been trying to improve our focus and attention as our main "behaviour for learning" target. We have learned how important it is to look at where the learning is happening, to have regular breaks, then be able to re-focus again. Not an easy skill (even for grown ups) but an essential skill to practice. How long can you focus on an activity at home? Can you improve this time?

The Ladybirds have shown some fantastic learning in maths this week using 2p coins to count in 2's and 10p coins to count in 10's. Very clever.

They have also been leading our "alphabet rap" every morning and can say both the name and the sound of every letter in the alphabet.

They have loved using the "thinking den" to think their own thoughts learning that their thoughts are unique to them.

The Bees have proudly published their stories based on the text "The Comet." They are really pleased with the results and want to put them on display and then share them with you at home. They worked really hard on their handwriting and presentation skills.

In maths the Yr 1's have been making sure they know their number bonds to 10 recalling them quickly. Why not use this link to practice at home?
