News from Infants (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2)


What a lovely week it has been in the Infant class, the children have all worked incredibly hard, been super focused and thrived on getting outside for their learning as much as possible.

It's been a real highlight being on the field for PE in the sunshine and we even made a start on practicing for our Sports Day races.














News from the Juniors (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)

For History this week Juniors have been learning about the impact WWI had on Britain during the conflict. Y3/4 explored the reasons for rationing and why it was needed during and after WWI. They took their ration books to shopkeepers, who cut out their tokens in exchange for bakery, meat and dairy items. They realised you had to think carefully about how much you could buy for the rations to last.

Year 5/6 explored how and why we remember WWI and the impacts it had on Britain. They researched topics including medicine, ammunition, animals, women's land army and technology.

In Year 3 and 4 this week we have been editing and improving our fantasy stories. We enjoyed finishing 'Mr Penguin and the lost treasure,'
