They thought hard about being clear and concise in their speech and listening carefully to each other, asking and answering questions.

News from the Juniors (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)

We have had a wonderful first week back. This week year 5 and 6 have been researching different mammals and creating fact files about them, including looking at the reproduction and gestation of mammals. Year 3 and 4 have been exploring roots, we looked at the function of roots and how they supply the plant with water and nutrients as well as keeping plants stable in the soil. We then went and dug up weeds on the field to investigate how roots look on different plants. We also looked at our beans that we have been growing in different conditions. We discovered that with no water the beans had not grown at all, but in all other conditions they had grown just not as well as we may have expected. We have also been thinking about D-Day as it was the 80th anniversary this week. The children have been researching this in groups and exploring what D-Day was and how it was so important in the war.
